## **PLANT DESCRIPTION**

<b>Plant Type:</b>	<b>Evergreen Climbing Rose</b>
<b>Height/Width:</b>	<b>10 ft. H x 20 ft. W or more</b>
<b>Plant Form:</b>	<b>Climbing / mounding – virtually thornless</b>
<b>Flower / Fruit:</b>	<b>Copious small violet-scented double white blooms</b>
<b>Leaf:</b>	<b>Dark green, pointed</b>
<b>Native To:</b>	<b>China</b>

## **GROWING REQUIREMENTS**

<b>Sunset Zones:</b>	<b>4-24</b>
<b>Soil:</b>	<b>Fast draining, rich</b>
<b>Water:</b>	<b>Moderate</b>
<b>Sun:</b>	<b>Full sun or light shade</b>
<b>Care and Pruning:</b>	<b>Can cut back hard <u>right after blooming</u> (cutting back in fall/winter cuts off flower buds). Very disease &amp; insect resistant.</b>

<b>GARDEN USE</b>	<b>Can be grown as large mounding shrub, climber, or hedge.</b>
