PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Drought resistant Perennial
Height / Width:	18" H x 3-4 ft. W
Plant Form:	Spreading underground, it can quickly make a solid cover 3 feet across
Flower / Fruit:	Masses of purple/blue flowers
Leaf Color, Size:	Small bright green
Native To:	A hybrid between two Mexican species, <i>S. coahuilensis</i> and <i>S. chamaedryoides</i>

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	7-24
Soil:	Well-drained
Water:	Low to moderate
Sun:	Full sun to light shade
Care and Pruning:	Cut back hard in late winter; trim lightly as needed in the growing season to keep tidy

GARDEN USE

Wonderful for softening the edges of paving and pathways or among large rocks. Attracts hummingbirds, bees and butterflies
