PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Drought resistant Deciduous shrub
Height / Width:	2 ft. H x 3 ft. W
Plant Form:	Rounded, branching from base
Flower / Fruit:	Two-tone white/ lavender pink flowers on 3-6 in. stems; blooms April until frost
Leaf Color, Size:	Linear glossy green ~1-in. long
Native To:	Texas, North-central Mexico

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	8-24
Soil:	Well-drained
Water:	Low
Sun:	Full sun; some shade in hottest climates
Care and Pruning:	Prune out dead flower stems as needed. Remove dead wood, shorten and shape plants before spring growth.

Good low hedge. Attracts
hummingbirds, butterflies.
