Purple Autumn Sage



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Deciduous shrub
Height / Width:	1-4 ft. H x 1-4 ft. W
Plant Form:	Rounded, branching from base
Flower / Fruit:	½-in. purple flowers on 3-6 inch stems; blooms April until frost
Leaf:	Glossy green ¾ to 1½ in. long
Native To:	Texas, North-central Mexico

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	8-24
Soil:	Well-drained
Water:	Drought-tolerant but does best with moderate water
Sun:	Full sun; some shade in hottest climates
Care and Pruning:	Prune out dead flower stems frequently. Remove dead wood, shorten and shape plants before spring growth.
