

# Salvia guaranitica 'Jean's Purple Passion'



## PLANT DESCRIPTION

<b>Plant Type:</b>	Herbaceous Perennial Annual in zones less than 8
<b>Height / Width:</b>	4-5 ft. H x 4-5 ft. W
<b>Plant Form:</b>	Upright, branching
<b>Flower / Fruit:</b>	2-in. purple blossoms with bright green calyxes turning purplish, on 1 ft. long stems. Blooms summer until frost
<b>Leaf Color, Size:</b>	Narrow heart-shaped, hairy, mint green, to 5 in. long
<b>Native To:</b>	South America

## GROWING REQUIREMENTS

<b>Sunset Zones:</b>	8, 9, 14-24
<b>Soil:</b>	Well-drained
<b>Water:</b>	Regular
<b>Sun:</b>	Full sun, tolerates partial shade in hottest climates
<b>Care and Pruning:</b>	Deadhead to encourage bloom Cut back to ground each winter
