Plant Form:	Compact
Flower / Fruit:	Magenta-pink to raspberry colored blooms May thru Nov
Leaf:	Medium green leaf with textured surface, bronzy winter tones
Native To:	Mexico

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	7 - 24
Soil:	Well-drained
Water:	Low to moderate
Sun:	Full sun or partial shade
Care and Pruning:	Prune out dead flower stems frequently. Remove dead wood, shorten and shape plants before spring growth.
