

# Sedum 'Autumn Joy' Stonecrop



## PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Succulent Perennial
Height / Width:	1-2 ft. H x 2 ft. W
Plant Form:	Upright clump
Flower / Fruit:	Rounded clusters of blossoms in late summer, pink when open, age to coppery pink, then attractive rusty color in fall
Leaf Color, Size:	Tiny little foliage "cabbages" appear by late winter, develop into a gray-green low mounds by summer
Native To:	Hybrid

## GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	1-10, 14-24
Soil:	Well-drained
Water:	Little to moderate – flops with too much water
Sun:	Full sun
Care and Pruning:	Low maintenance. Remove spent foliage and flowers when they become unattractive.
