PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Succulent Perennial
Height / Width:	1 in. H x spreading W
Plant Form:	Trailing, creeping mat
Flower / Fruit:	White star shaped flowers appear at the tips of stems for a short time in midsummer
Leaf Color, Size:	Tiny green leaves on long stems which grow closely packed together; fall color pink to maroon depending on coldness. Foliage persists throughout the winter.
Native To:	Mexico

Sunset Zones:	4-9, 16-24
Soil:	Well-drained, porous soil
Water:	Low to moderate
Sun:	Partial shade
Care and Pruning:	Low maintenance
