PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Evergreen tree
Height / Width:	70-90 ft H x 15-30 ft W
Plant Form:	Symmetrical pyramid with straight trunk, nearly horizontal branching
Flower / Fruit:	Small roundish brown cones, 1 inch diameter
Leaf:	Flat, pointed, narrow inch-long, medium green on top, grayish below, in one plane on both sides of stems, like a feather
Native To:	Coastal California, Oregon

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Zones:	4-9, 14-24
Soil:	Well-drained
Water:	Moderate to regular
Sun:	Full sun or light shade
Care and Pruning:	Low maintenance, pest-free, fast-growing

GARDEN USE Groves (plant 7 ft. apart) or hedge (plant 3-4 ft. apart), in lawns
