## Lamb's Ears



### PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Perennial
Height / Width:	1½ ft. H to spreading
Plant Form:	Shrubby, dense
Flower / Fruit:	Blossom stalks 18 in. tall bear small purplish flowers
Leaf:	Rosettes of soft, thick, tongue-shaped wooly white leaves
Native To:	Caucasus, Iran

### GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Zones:	1-24
Soil:	Well-drained
Water:	Moderate to Low
Sun:	Full sun to light shade
Care and Pruning:	If clumps eventually die out in center, divide and replant outer sections. Spreads by surface runners

### GARDEN USE

Edging for paths, flower beds, groundcover, contrast with darker colors
