| <b>Flower / Fruit:</b>   | <b>Bell-shaped, white or pink tinged flowers followed by small purplish red fruit in fall</b> |
| <b>Leaf Color, Size:</b> | <b>Oval to elliptic bluish-green leaves (to 2½ in. long)</b>                                  |
| <b>Native To:</b>        | <b>Eastern United States</b>  |

| <b>Soil:</b>             | <b>Tolerates wide range of soils</b>                     |
| <b>Water:</b>            | <b>Moderate</b>  |
| <b>Sun:</b>              | <b>Full sun to partial shade</b>                         |
| <b>Care and Pruning:</b> | <b>Remove root suckers and runners to control spread</b> |
