

Tanacetum parthenium 'Aureum' Golden Feverfew



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Perennial
Height / Width:	1 ft. H x 1 ft. W
Plant Form:	Mounded, spreading, dwarf
Flower / Fruit:	Small daisies with white rays and bright yellow centers
Leaf Color, Size:	Aromatic, feathery, fern-like, chartreuse-colored foliage
Native To:	Southern Europe, Caucasus

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	2-24
Soil:	Well drained, improved by organic matter
Water:	Regular watering necessary
Sun:	Full sun to partial shade
Care and Pruning:	Cut back to new growth after bloom to restrain re-seeding, divide in spring

GARDEN USE

Grown for colorful foliage in the front of the border or as bright groundcover. Use in naturalized areas or cottage gardens where it can freely self-seed.
