Plant Type:	Shrubby Perennial
Height / Width:	4-8 ft. H x 4-8 ft. W
Plant Form:	Loose
Flower / Fruit:	Continuous show of lavender-blue spikes at branch ends
Leaf Color, Size:	Gray-green with silvery undersides, 1 in. long
Native To:	Mediterranean region

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	4-24
Soil:	Not fussy
Water:	Very low to moderate Do not overwater!
Sun:	Full sun
Care and Pruning:	Cut back before spring growth begins
