

Thymus pseudolanuginosus

Woolly Thyme



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Shrubby Perennial
Height / Width:	2-3 in. H x 3 ft. W
Plant Form:	Mat-forming, flat to undulating
Flower / Fruit:	Blooms seldom and sparsely, pinkish flowers in midsummer
Leaf Color, Size:	Stems densely clothed in small, gray, woolly, aromatic leaves
Native To:	Mediterranean region

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	1-24
Soil:	Light, well-drained soil that is fairly dry
Water:	Moderate (shallow roots – does not like to dry completely out)
Sun:	Full sun to light shade
Care and Pruning:	Restrain plants as needed by cutting back growing tips, may become rangy in winter
