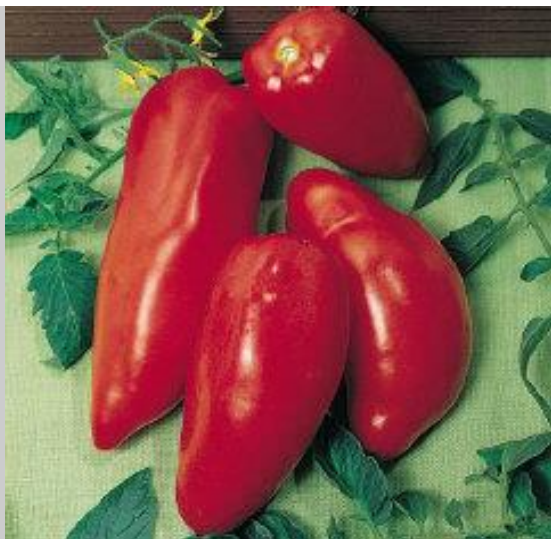


# Open-Pollinated Heirloom

### GROWING REQUIREMENTS

**Days to Harvest:** 85 days

**Soil:** Fertile, well drained  
pH 5.5 – 6.8

### PLANT DESCRIPTION

Long, 4 to 6", pepper-shaped type with fruits growing clustered in groups of 2 to 5. So sweet and refreshing, it can be eaten straight off the vine, but is highly prized for sauces and canning. Fruits are far richer and more flavorful than most paste tomatoes.
