

# Verbena lasioostachys

## Western Vervain



### PLANT DESCRIPTION

<b>Plant Type:</b>	<b>Perennial</b>
<b>Height / Width:</b>	<b>2-3 ft. H x 2-3 ft. W</b>
<b>Plant Form:</b>	<b>Erect or diffusely branched and spreading</b>
<b>Flower / Fruit:</b>	<b>Covered with small blue verbena flowers all summer</b>
<b>Leaf Color, Size:</b>	<b>Broadly ovate or oblong-ovate 1-4 in. long, coarsely serrate</b>
<b>Native To:</b>	<b>California to Oregon</b>

### GROWING REQUIREMENTS

<b>USDA Zones:</b>	<b>4-10</b>
<b>Soil:</b>	<b>Tolerates sand, clay, and no drainage</b>
<b>Water:</b>	<b>Low to moderate. Tolerates seasonal flooding</b>
<b>Sun:</b>	<b>Full sun</b>
<b>Care / Pruning:</b>	<b>Be aware: aggressive growth and reseeding</b>

### GARDEN USE

**Consider when hydroseeding or planting for erosion control. Tolerates deer.**
