PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Perennial
Height / Width:	1 ft. H x 3 ft. W
Plant Form:	Mounding
Flower / Fruit:	Lilac-colored flowers bloom from spring to fall
Leaf Color, Size:	Light green, deeply cut leaves
Native To:	Baja California

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	12-24
Soil:	Well drained soil
Water:	Little to moderate water
Sun:	Full sun; mildews in shade
Care and Pruning:	Cut back to fresh growth when rangy (late summer – fall). Cut foliage to growing points (1-2 in.) after frost.

GARDEN USE **Fast growing, reseeds freely. Useful ground cover for hot, dry sites. Attracts butterflies.**
