PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Perennial
Height/Width:	1-2 ft. H x 3-4 ft. W
Plant Form:	Dense, spreading clumps
Flower/Fruit:	Showy lilac cylindrical clusters on tall upright stems; early summer to early autumn (if deadheaded)
Leaf:	Rigid, to 3 in. long, toothed, rough
Native To:	South America

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	3-24
Soil:	Well-drained soil
Water:	Moderate to regular
Sun:	Full sun
Care and Pruning:	Shear with weedeater after bloom to encourage rebloom. Cut back again in late fall.
