## PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Herbaceous Perennial
Height / Width:	6 in. H x 2 ft. W
Plant Form:	Mat forming
Flower / Fruit:	Profuse, white-eyed, saucer-shaped deep blue flowers, in early spring
Leaf Color, Size:	Small, dark green, turning bronze in winter
Native To:	Eurasia

## GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	2-9, 14-24
Soil:	Poor to moderate fertility, well- drained
Water:	Regular
Sun:	Full sun to partial shade in hottest climates
Care and Pruning:	Vigorous grower, apply winter mulch in cold climates, divide in spring. Low maintenance.

Provides color to the perennial border front, or rock garden. Effective as an edging plant or as a small-scale groundcover.
