PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Deciduous Vine
Height / Width:	To 30 ft.
Plant Form:	Climbing with tendrils
Flower / Fruit:	Summer flowers are yellow-green and fragrant, followed by small, insignificant clusters of purple grapes
Leaf Color, Size:	2-4 in. gray-green, turn red/orange in autumn.
Native To:	California, Oregon

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	4-24
Soil:	Rich, moisture-retentive soils
Water:	Moderate
Sun:	Full sun or partial shade in hottest climates
Care and Pruning:	Prune as needed before spring growth begins. Slow to establish, then grows fast

Favorite for covering arbors, walls, or fences. Wildlife food and cover. Bees favor flowers.
