### PLANT DESCRIPTION

<b>Plant Type:</b>	<b>Evergreen tree or shrub</b>
<b>Height / Width:</b>	<b>10-15 ft. H x 10-15 ft. W</b>
<b>Plant Form:</b>	<b>Multi-stemmed tree or shrub</b>
<b>Flower / Fruit:</b>	<b>Yellow clusters, early spring</b>
<b>Leaf Color, Size:</b>	<b>Silvery gray, shaped like 1-in.-long knife blades</b>
<b>Native To:</b>	<b>Australia</b>

### GROWING REQUIREMENTS

<b>Sunset Zones:</b>	<b>12-24</b>
<b>Soil:</b>	<b>Moderately fertile</b>
<b>Water:</b>	<b>Little or no water</b>
<b>Sun:</b>	<b>Full sun</b>

**Care and Pruning:** Naturally a multi-stemmed tree. Pruning can form it into a multi-stemmed bush, a tree or cascading bush.
