PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Deciduous Tree
Height / Width:	60 ft. H x 30 ft. W
Plant Form:	Upright, irregular form with multiple trunks, fast growing
Flower / Fruit:	Pink inflorescences with long, drooping pedicels
Leaf Color, Size:	Broadleaf light green pinnately divided with winged seed capsules
Native To:	Central & Northern California

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	1-9, 14-24
Soil:	Not particular; tolerates sand, clay
Water:	Needs moisture at first, then very drought resistant
Sun:	Full sun
Care / Pruning:	Needs little pruning

One of toughest shade trees around. Provides a very fast windbreak. Tolerates wind, heat, seasonal flooding, deer
