

Achillea tomentosa Woolly Yarrow



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Perennial groundcover
Height / Width:	6 in. H x 18 in. W
Plant Form:	Flat, spreading mat
Flower / Fruit:	Golden flower heads in flat clusters top 6-10 in. stems in June through September
Leaf Color, Size:	Fernlike, gray-green, soft & fuzzy
Native To:	Europe, western Asia

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	1-24
Soil:	Well-drained, but will tolerate wide range of soils
Water:	Little to moderate. Drought-tolerant when established.
Sun:	Full sun
Care and Pruning:	Shear off dead flowers to leave attractive soft gray-green mat Divide every 2 to 4 years
