PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Evergreen Perennial
Height / Width:	< 4 in. H x 12-24 in. W
Plant Form:	Graceful, fan shaped
Flower / Fruit:	Insignificant, sedge-like flower spikes of tiny, densely-packed, greenish-yellow flowers in spring; giving way to tiny fleshy berries
Leaf Color, Size:	Chartreuse, sedge-like, narrow, fanning; spicy sweet fragrance
Native To:	Northern Hemisphere

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	3b-10, 14-24
Soil:	Moist
Water:	Moderate once established, grows well in boggy conditions
Sun:	Part shade to shade
Care / Pruning:	Low maintenance. Tough plant.

GARDEN USE

Brightens moist shady areas. Perfect for edging walkways, in groupings, between stepping stones or as a groundcover. Fabulous foliage. Deer resistant.
