

Alcea rosea 'Queeny Purple' Hollyhock



DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Biennial or short-lived perennial
Height / Width:	2-3 ft. H x 3 ft. W
Plant Form:	Upright clump
Flower / Fruit:	Profuse, double 3- to 4-inch purple flowers
Leaf Color, Size:	Big, rough, heart-shaped, green
Native To:	Mediterranean region

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	1-24
Soil:	Well drained soil
Water:	Regular
Sun:	Full sun to partial shade

Care and Pruning: Watch for slugs and snails. After flowers fade, cut stalks just above ground. Feed & water to encourage late summer to fall rebloom
